II. SHOW DATES

- A. Application for show dates shall be made on a form provided by the Association.
- B. Dues of \$50.00 for local shows and \$75 for USEF rated shows must accompany application for show dates; cancellation will result in forfeiture of dues.
- C. To maintain comparable dates and to be included in the Roster of shows which is mailed to all members, applications for dates must be received by November 30 of the previous year.
- D. **New show** dates must be applied for at least thirty (30) days prior to show.
- E. NR (local), C and B rated shows may not have conflicting weekend dates within a fifty (50) mile radius. Dates will be approved on a first-come, first-serve basis.

III. PRIZE LIST AND SHOW RESULTS

- A. Show results must be forwarded to Jennifer Duncan, 1742 Lakewood Lane, Lexington, KY 40502, by certified mail with return receipt requested and must be postmarked within ten (10) days of the show. Failure to do so will result in a \$50.00 fine and no subsequent dates will be granted until the fine is paid.
- B. ***Point standings will be mailed out to those who request them on the membership form in June and December. For those that wish not to receive them by mail, a mass e-mail will be sent at the same time. You will have 2 weeks to make inquiries to the Association's secretary via e-mail. After 2 weeks, the points will be considered official.***
- C. Prize lists must state the following:
 - 1) ASTM approved helmets must be worn.
 - 2) Martingales are not permitted in under saddle classes.

IV. SHOW OFFICIALS

- A. Judges. All judges must be recognized by the USEF with a Registered or Recorded status in the divisions in which they officiate.
- B. *Local shows may have knowledgeable horsepersons who do not have USEF status as judges.
- C. Stewards. A Steward must be recognized by the USEF. The Steward is to protect the interests of the Exhibitors, Judges, and Show Management, but not necessarily the KHJA.

- D. A KHJA Board Member will officiate in the capacity of a steward in the event of a dispute.

V. DEFINITIONS

- A. ***A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing over 3' to 3'3" fences at USEF Regular Member or Canadian Equestrian Federation or any national or international competition. Fences not to exceed 3'3". A 3' section must be offered and a 3'3" section may be offered. Horses may only compete in one height section at a show but may alternate from one show to another. Once a horse has shown 3'6" he is not eligible to compete in the Pre-Green Hunter division, regardless of age. Exception: green reinstatements. Pre-Green may not be reinstated. There will be two annual awards for the Pre-Green division: 3' and 3'3".***

B. Working Hunter.

- (a) A **Green Hunter** is a horse in its first or second calendar year of showing in any class in any horse show requiring horses to jump over 3'3".

Open to Regular Competitors only.

- (b) **Regular Working Hunter:** 3'9" to 4'. Open to Regular Competitors only.

- (c) **First Year:** 3'6". At shows which are not regular members of the USEF, 3'3" is recommended prior to June 1.

- (d) **Second Year:** 3'9". At shows which are not regular members of the USEF, 3'6" is recommended prior to June 1.

- (e) Separate awards will be made if at least three (3) horses obtain points in each classification.

(f) If entries warrant, divisions will be combined and will jump at their respective height.

C. Low Hunter. A Low Hunter is a horse or pony of any classification.

3' to 3'3". Open to Local Competitors

D. Adult Amateur Hunter.

2'9" to 3'. Open to both Local and Regular Competitors

- (a) Riders 35 years old and younger.

- (b) Riders over 35 years old.

- (c) Separate awards will be made if at least three (3) horses obtain points in each classification.

- (d) At local shows may be combined with Children's Hunter if there are fewer than three (3) entries.

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except the Adult Amateur Jumper and Amateur Owner Hunter. Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter division may compete 1 different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division and must own or have an USEF registered lease of said horse. Fences to be set between 2'9" to 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Entries need not be jogged for soundness. An unrestricted Children's/Adult Hunter division may be offered and be open to all Amateurs and Juniors and fences are not to exceed 3'3".

E. Children's Hunter.

3'. Open to both Local and Regular Competitors

(a) At local shows may be combined with Adult Amateur Hunter if there are fewer than three (3) entries.

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Neither horses nor riders may cross enter into the Junior Hunter section at the same show. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show, except Medal classes, age group equitation classes and Children's Jumper classes. Ponies may not compete in the Children's section if also entered in the pony division at the same show. Fence heights 2'9" to 3'; spreads not to exceed fence heights. Entries need not be jogged for soundness. An unrestricted Children's/Adult Hunter division may be offered and be open to all Amateurs and Juniors; fence heights not to exceed 3'3".

F. Junior Hunter: Open to Regular competitors (3'6").

(a) Separate classifications may be offered for Small Horses (under 16 hands tall) and for Large Horses (16 hands tall and over.)

(b) Separate awards will be made if at least three (3) horses obtain points in each classification.

G. Amateur Owner Hunter: Open to Regular Competitors only (3'6").

(a) Riders 35 years old and younger.

(b) Riders over 35 years old.

(c) Separate awards will be made if at least three (3) horses obtain points in each classification.

H. 3'3" Amateur Owner Hunter: Open to Regular members only.

I. Pony Hunter: Open to Regular Competitors only.

(a) Small (not to exceed 12.2 hands): 2'3"

(b) Medium (over 12.2, not to exceed 13.2 hands): 2'6".

(c) Large (over 13.2, not to exceed 14.2 hands): 3'.

(d) All ponies may be shown at their respective fence heights in a combined class, or may be shown in individual classes divided into all three fence-height classifications, or may be shown in combined Small/Medium class and Large class.

(e) Separate awards will be made if at least three ponies obtain points in each classification. If less than three Small Ponies or three Medium Ponies fail to obtain points, the award will be combined for Small and Medium.

J. Green Pony Hunter: Open to Regular Competitors only.

(a) Small (not to exceed 12.2 hands): 2'3".

(b) Medium (over 12.2, not to exceed 13.2 hands): 2'6".

(c) Large (over 13.2, not to exceed 14.2 hands): 2'9".

(d) All ponies may be shown at their respective fence heights in a combined class, or may be shown in individual classes divided into all three fence-height classifications, or may be shown in combined Small/Medium class and Large class.

(e) Separate awards will be made if at least three ponies obtain points in each classification. If less than three Small Ponies or three Medium Ponies fail to obtain points, the award will be combined for Small and Medium.

K. Children's Hunter Pony: Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show, except Medal classes, age group equitation classes and Children's Jumper classes. The combination pony/rider is not eligible for USEF rated classes at the same show. Any rider competing in the rated pony hunter division may only show one pony in the children's hunter pony division. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as a Children's Hunter Pony. To be offered at two heights: fences 2' for small and medium and 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies need not be jogged for soundness. No in and outs. Zone award will be presented annually as two sections: small/medium and large.

L. Hunter Seat Equitation: Open to both Regular and Local competitors who still retain their amateur status.

(a) 11 years old and under: 2' to **2'3"**.

(b) 12 through 14 years old: 2'6" to 3'.

(c) 15 through 17 years old: 3' to 3'6".

(d) Short Stirrup, 11 years old and younger: 1'6" to 2'.

(e) **Long Stirrup, 12 years and over: 1'6" to 2'.**

(f) Adult: **2'9"** to 3'3".

(g) All age groups may be shown separately or in a combined class at their respective fence heights or classes may be divided into 14 years old and younger, and 15 through 17 years old.

(h) Awards:

i. Separate Regular awards will be given if at least three riders obtain points in each classification. If less than three riders under 11 years old and less than three riders 12 through 14 years old fail to obtain points, the award will be combined for those 14 years old and younger.

ii. Separate Local awards will be given for 11 and Under, 12-14 and 15-17 if at least three riders obtain points in each classification.

If two of the three classifications have at least three riders obtaining points, the classification without the minimum number will be combined with the closest age group. In the case that the 12-14 year classification does not have the minimum number, that classification will be combined with the division which has the least number of riders.

If two or more of the three classifications do not have at least three riders obtaining points, the entire division will be combined.

M. Jumper: Pre/Intermediate Children's/Adult Jumpers, Hopeful Jumpers and Training or Schooling Jumpers are Local divisions. Children's/Adult Jumpers is a Local and Regular division, all other classifications are Regular divisions.

(a) Hopeful Jumpers: 2'6" to 3'.

(b) Pre/Intermediate Children's/Adult Jumpers: 2'6" to 3'.

i. Rider may not cross enter into any class where fences are higher than 3'.

(c) Children's/Adult Jumper: 3'3" to 3'6" at regular shows, 3' to 3'6" at local shows.

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into the Junior Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into Low Junior Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above **1.30 meters** in any open class at the same show. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may also be combined with the Adult Amateur Jumper section, if so stated in the prize list. Fences to be set at USEF **1.05 meters**, however shows may offer one class at **1.15 meters**.

(d) Adult Amateur Jumpers:

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. All exhibitors must be Amateurs in accordance with GR 808 and must show USEF Amateur certification. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into the Low Amateur Owner Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above

1.30 meters in any open class at the same show. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may be combined with the Children's Jumper section, if so stated in the prize list. Fences to be set at USEF **1.05 meters**, however shows may offer one class at **1.15 meters**.

(e) Training or Schooling: 3'3" to 3'6"

(f) Pony Jumpers: Open to Regular competitors. A pony, 14.2 hands and under in height, that is ridden by an individual who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. Cash winnings do not influence this classification.

(i) Pony Jumper classes may be conducted under the following USEF Articles and Tables:

Table I – Touch classes.

Table II – Knockdown Classes (Except Table II, Sec. 4, Table II, Sec. 5, Table II, Sec. 6, Table II, Sec. 8, Table II, Sec. 9).

Table IV.

(ii) Final obstacles of all combinations in Pony Jumper classes may not be spreads. All entrants will compete over same heights, spreads, and distances.

(iii) Pony Jumper may offer classes at **.95 meters, 1.0 meters, or 1.05 meters** as specified in Prize List. Local Competitions – no minimum height or spread, but fence dimensions must be stated in the Prize List.

The Time Allowed is based on minimum speed of 360 or 382 yards per minute for Pony Jumpers. The speed to be used for each class or section must be indicated in the prize list.

(iv) The following fence dimensions define each level:

.95 meters. Fences 2'9" to 3'0" in height and 3'0" to 3'6" in spread (Triple bars/liverpools to 4').

1.0 meters. Fences 3'0" to 3'3" in height and 3'3" to 3'9" in spread. (Triple bars/liverpools to 4'3").

1.05 meters. Fences 3'3" to 3'6" in height and 3'6" to 4'0" in spread. (Triple bars/liverpools to 4'6").

(g) Modified Junior/Amateur: 3'9"

i. Horse, rider combination may not cross enter into any other jumper division at the same show except for training and schooling.

(h) Junior/Amateur Owner: 3'6" to 4'6".

i. Standings based on money earned.

(i) Open Jumpers: 3'6" to 4'9", **1.15 meters and up. 1.20 meters and up**

i. Standings based on money earned.

ii. Separate awards will be given if at least three horses earn money in each classification.

N. Short Stirrup: 1'6" to 2'. Open to both Regular and Local competitors.

For riders 11 years and under. Cross entering by rider at the same show is not permitted into classes with fences exceeding 2', except 11 & under equitation. If a rider competes in 2 horse shows where the fences are 2'6" or higher, they will not be eligible to compete in this division the following year. Fence height 1'6" to 2'.

A) May be combined with Long Stirrup if there are less than three (3) entries.

O. Long Stirrup: 1'6" to 2'. Open to Local competitors.

Long Stirrup. For riders 12 and over. Cross entering by rider at the same show is not permitted into classes with fences exceeding 2', except in equitation. Fence height 1'6" to 2'.

A) May be combined with Short Stirrup if there are less than three (3) entries.

P. Breeding: Open to Regular Competitors only.

(a) Yearling.

(b) Two Year Old.

(c) Three Year Old.

Q. Limit Rider: Open to Local Competitors only. To be judged as a hunter class

(a) A Limit Rider is one that has not won more than six blue ribbons over 2'6" fences at KHJA shows. Riders may compete based on their status as of December 1.

(b) A rider who competes on more than one horse in this division at one show may only receive the points earned by the leading horse at that show.

R. Baby Green: 2'6" Open to Local and Regular Competitors.

(a) Open to horses that have not shown over fences higher than 2'9".

(b) Horses may not cross enter at the same show into any class where fences exceed 2'9".

(c) Eligibility for this division is 2 years.

S. Special Hunter: 2'6" Open to all horses/ponies/riders. No year end award will be given in this division.

T. Pre/Intermediate Children's Hunter: 2'3" to 2'6". Open to Regular and Local horses and ponies ridden by a junior exhibitor. Rider may not cross enter into any class where fences are 3' or higher.

(a) May be combined with Intermediate Adult Hunter if there are less than three (3) entries.

U. Pre/Intermediate Adult Hunter: 2'3" to 2'6". Open to Regular and Local horses and ponies ridden by an adult, amateur exhibitor. Rider may not cross enter into any class where fences are 3' or higher.

(a) May be combined with Intermediate Children's Hunter if there are less than three (3) entries.

V. Beginner Horse/Pony: 2'. Open to Local horses in their first or second year of showing, that have never shown higher than 2'6". To be judged as a hunter class.

(a) Trotting not to be penalized.

W. Beginner Rider: 2'. Open to Local riders in their first or second year of showing, that have never shown higher than 2'6". To be judged as a hunter class..

(a) Trotting not to be penalized.

X. Cross-Rail Equitation: Open to Local riders only of any age who have not shown over a course of fences 2' or higher.

- (a) Trotting is not to be penalized.
- (b) Eligibility for this division is two (2) years.
- (c) Division may be held as 8 and Under and 9 and Over. One year-end award will be given.

Y. Cross-Rails Green Horse/Pony: Open to Local horses or ponies that have not shown over a course of fences 2' or higher. No year-end award will be given in this division.

- (a) Trotting is not to be penalized.

Z. Walk-Trot Equitation: Open to beginner Local riders of any age only.

- (a) May cross-enter into Cross-Rail classes.
- (b) If rider enters any over-fences class other than Cross-Rails, the rider is eligible for Walk-Trot for the remainder of that year only.
- (c) Eligibility for this division is one (1) year.
- (d) Division may be held as 8 and Under and 9 and Over. One year-end award will be given.

VI. HIGH POINT AWARDS

A. Terms of Competition. Separate Annual Local and Regular Awards will be made to horses and riders which score the highest number of points in their classification at shows recognized by KHJA from December 1 to November 30 under the following conditions:

1. Horse and/or rider must have declared as competing for awards in Local or Regular when registered. If no declaration is made at that time, the horse and/or rider will automatically be registered as Regular.
2. During any one year, no horse/rider combination may be eligible for both Regular and Local awards.
3. Local competitors may move up to the Regular division by submitting a written notice by return mail *or e-mail* to the association's secretary. Regular Members will not be allowed to move down to the Local division during the current competition year.
4. If a local member showing in a regular division competes in five (5) or more rated horse shows, they will automatically become a regular member.
5. A horse that has not been recorded as a Lifetime member must be recorded annually and the owner of record must be a member of KHJA.
6. Horses must be recorded annually and the owner of record must be a member of KHJA.
7. A classification must be offered in at least four approved shows.
8. Only classes that follow KHJA specifications will be counted.
9. **No points will be counted in a class if fewer than three (3) entries have entered and competed. No championship or reserve points will be counted if there are fewer than three (3) entries in each class of the division.**

10. Points accumulated toward High Score Awards by any horse found to have received a forbidden substance and penalized by the USEF shall be nullified for that year by the KHJA.
11. If there are not at least 3 horses/ponies/riders in a division, you must have accumulated a minimum of 30 points for Local, 80 points for Regular and shown **and placed a minimum of three (3) horse shows during the year** to be eligible for a year-end award.

2. Division champions will be awarded 2.0 time the total first place point value of the first class in that section.
3. Division reserve champions will be awarded 1.5 time the total first place value of the first class in that section.
4. Classifications will be rated as follows for Regular competitors.:
 - (a) Pre-Green and Adult Amateur Hunters will be rated according to the highest rated Hunter Section at the same show.
 - (b) Children's Hunter and Equitation will be rated according to the highest rated Junior or Pony Hunter Section at the same show.

C. Grand Hunter Champion Awards.

1. Regular Competitors:
 - (a) Senior Exhibitor: The horse earning the most points in any one hunter division shall be named Grand Champion.
 - (b) Junior Exhibitor: The horse or pony earning the most points in any one hunter division shall be named Grand Champion.
2. Local Competitors
 - (a) The horse earning the most points in any one hunter division shall be named Grand Champion.

VII. THE OFFICIAL KHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL CLASSES

- A. The KHJA offers five Hunter Seat Medal Classes: Pony, Horse 3' and over, Horse 2'6", 2'.
- B. To be eligible for KHJA Medal classes, a rider:
 1. Must be a member of the Association prior to closing of entries.
 2. Must ride in two (2) KHJA shows prior to the show in which the Medal Classes are held.
 3. May enter one (1) Medal Class only.
- C. Ponies and Horses: To be shown over a minimum of ten (10) fences with at least two (2) changes of direction after the first fence and at least one combination at fence heights:
 1. Ponies: Respective heights for their size. (See KHJA V, I).
 2. Horses: 3' to 3'6".
 3. Horses: 2'6".
 4. Horse/Pony 2'.

- D. Riders must show at the height at which they have been competing throughout the current show year.
- E. A minimum of twelve (12) riders, if available. They will be selected from each class to show at a walk, trot and canter. They will be judged on seat, hands guidance and control of horse, with each phase of the competition counting 50%. USEF tests 1-19. A Medal and eight ribbons will be awarded in each class. USEF Tests are available at www.usef.org.
- F. A ride-off with the first and second placed riders of each Medal will be held. Testing to be at the judge's discretion. Ribbons will be awarded to the top 4 riders. Winner will receive a perpetual trophy.
- G. ***Due to the World Equestrian Games, the KHJA Medal class will be held this year only during the September Lakeside Arena show. This show will be B rated and the Medal Finals will be held Saturday night.***

VIII. COURSES

- A. A course must consist of at least six fences.
- B. Fifty percent or more of the fences must be the height stated in the prize list and none shall be over or under 2 inches except any first fence, brush fence, ditch or bank.
- C. A ground line is recommended for all fences.
- D. The courses must be posted at least one hour before the class.
- E. Except in case of bad weather, broken equipment, or similar emergency a course may not be altered except by written permission of all exhibitors. If one or more fences are rendered unusable during a class and no duplicate exists, management may substitute fences which approximate as nearly as possible the originals.
- F. No class over fences shall be started one half hour after sunset unless the area has adequate lighting.
- G. Member shows may consult the Association if any help is needed in laying out their courses.

IX. PROTEST

A protest may be made to the Board of KHJA. It must be:

- A. In writing.
- B. Signed by the protestor.
- C. Addressed to the Secretary of KHJA, describing the violation and at which show it occurred.
- D. Accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00.

- E. Received by an official of KHJA within a timely manner of the alleged violation. The protest will be addressed by a Ethics Committee.

X. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HORSE SHOW MANAGEMENT

- A. Qualified medical personnel with no other duties and suitable medical equipment, must be present during scheduled schooling sessions over fences and during all scheduled performances. Qualified medical personnel is defined as a person who is currently certified or licensed in their profession and trained in pre-hospital trauma care. EMT/paramedics would serve as the highest qualified for that responsibility followed next by doctors, nurses and/or certified athletic trainers. An ambulance must be on the grounds or on call.
- B. Veterinarian, Blacksmith and Doctor must be on call. All horses coming into the state of Kentucky must have Coggins test and **Health Certificate**. (Must be stated on prize list.)
- C. Any participant in amateur classes MUST POSSESS AND PRESENT to the Horse Show Secretary a current amateur card from the USEF or sign an application with the show secretary before entering a class.
- D. Ponies and Junior Hunters without an USEF measurement card must be accurately measured.
- E. Judges must be furnished with cards, which have class specifications and course.
- F. Schooling area must provide a trot fence, a vertical fence and a spread fence.

XI. FOR LOCAL HORSE SHOW

- A. Award six ribbons in all classes for Exhibitors.
- B. **An ASTM approved helmet must be worn by all participants.**
- C. Mail an extra set of results to horse magazines such as *The Chronicle*.

XII. ASSOCIATION PAGE

This must appear in a conspicuous position in the prize list and in the catalogue, if printed.

The _____ Horse Show is operated in accordance with the current rules of the Kentucky Hunter and Jumper Association.

To be eligible for the Annual High Score Awards the owners must be a member and the horse or pony must be registered with the Association.

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except the Adult Amateur Jumper and Amateur Owner Hunter. Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter division may compete 1 different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division and must own or have an USEF registered lease of said horse. Fences to be set between 2'9" to 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Entries need not be jogged for soundness. An unrestricted Children's/Adult Hunter division may be offered and be open to all Amateurs and Juniors and fences are not to exceed 3'3".

Children's Hunter:

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Neither horses nor riders may cross enter into the Junior Hunter section at the same show. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show, except Medal classes, age group equitation classes and Children's Jumper classes. Ponies may not compete in the Children's section if also entered in the pony division at the same show. Fence heights 2'9" to 3'; spreads not to exceed fence heights. Entries need not be jogged for soundness. An unrestricted Children's/Adult Hunter division may be offered and be open to all Amateurs and Juniors and fences are not to exceed 3'3".

Children's Hunter Pony:

Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show, except Medal classes, age group equitation classes and Children's Jumper classes. The combination pony/rider is not eligible for USEF rated classes at the same show. Any rider competing in the rated pony hunter division may only show one pony in the children's hunter pony division. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as a Children's Hunter Pony. To be offered at two heights: fences 2' for small and medium and 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies need not be jogged for soundness. No in and outs. Zone award will be presented annually as two sections: small/medium and large.

Children's Jumper:

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Junior Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into Low Junior Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above 1.30m (4'3") in

any open class at the same show. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may also be combined with the Adult Amateur Jumper section, if so stated in the prize list. Fences to be set at 3'6" or 1.10m; however shows may offer one class at 1.15m (3'9").

Adult Amateur Jumpers:

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. All exhibitors must be Amateurs in accordance with GR1306 and must show USEF Amateur certification. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into the Low Amateur Owner Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above 1.30m (4'3") in any open class at the same show. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may be combined with the Children's Jumper section, if so stated in the prize list. Fences to be set at 3'6" or 1.10m; however shows may offer one class at 1.15m (3'9").

Pre-Green Hunter

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing over 3' to 3'3" fences at USEF Regular Member or Canadian Equestrian Federation or any national or international competition. Fences not to exceed 3'3". A 3' section must be offered and a 3'3" section may be offered. Horses may only compete in one height section at a show but may alternate from one show to another. Once a horse has shown 3'6" he is not eligible to compete in the Pre-Green Hunter division, regardless of age. Exception: green reinstatements. **Pre-Green may not be reinstated. There will be two annual awards for the Pre-Green division: 3' and 3'3".**
