No numbers will be released until all signatures are in order.

STABLING

The Kentucky Horse Park offers 10'x12' permanent stalls. Stall fee is \$175 for KHJA members and \$200 for nonmembers per stall. Stalls will be available Thursday, September 16, and they must be vacated at the completion of the show, September 19. Early arrivals and late departures must be cleared through the show office at a fee of \$50 per night per stall. A trailer-in fee of \$40 per entry will be added to all entries shipping in without a stall. *Stalls may be reserved by text or through the online entry system.*

ENTRIES

Entries close Tuesday, September 6, 2021. Post entries will be accepted and will incur a late fee of \$10. Entry fees will be considered for processing only when signed by owner, rider, trainer, and coach. They must also be accompanied by a check for stabling fees. There will be no add-scratch fees for the show. We encourage exhibitors to enter classes the day before by 5:00 p.m.

The 2021 KHJA Fall Horse Show will use the Show Management System™ On-Line Entry Platform to accept electronic entries for the competitions. This service is billed as part of your office fee and we encourage you to use the Show Management System platform. Exhibitors will be able to enter the show electronically as well as view their bills online. To submit entries or learn more about the electronic entry process, please visit

entries.showmanagementsystem.com. Note: A 3% non-refundable convenience fee will be assessed for all credit card charges.

REFUNDS

Entries for classes will be refunded upon presentation of a vet certificate pronouncing the horse unfit to show. If a horse is deemed unfit to show, the stall fee will be refunded and that entry will endure a scratch fee of \$30.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND FACILITY FEE

The administration fee includes the schooling, medic, and office fee. The administration fee is \$45 per horse. The equine facility fee is \$10 per horse.

COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES

Proof of negative Coggins, within one year, is required for every horse entering the Kentucky Horse Park. Proof of a vet inspection certificate within 30 days for all out-of-state horses is required. In-state horses must be accompanied by a Kentucky Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within 150 days.

SCHOOLING

The Stonelea and Claiborne rings will be available for schooling from 8:00 AM to 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 16. Schooling fee is included in the administration fee.

MANAGEMENT AND CONDITIONS

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. They also reserve the right to refuse any entry or move classes as deemed fit.

The Kentucky Horse Park, organizers, officials, volunteers, or workers of the the KHJA Fall Classic will not be held responsible for accidents, thefts, or injuries to rider, horse, guest, spectator, groom, or equipment at the show. This will be a condition of entry to the showgrounds.

RIBBONS AND TROPHIES

Six ribbons will be offered in each class. A champion and reserve champion trophy will be offered in each division. The champion and reserve champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter division. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for one under saddle class. Prize money will be applied to your final invoice. Any credit will be sent by mail following the show.

POLING

Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited at all times on the grounds of the Kentucky Horse Park. In the event of a violation of this regulation, the involved horse and its trainer of record as indicated on the entry form will be suspended from further competition.

JUMP ORDER

A rotation jump order will be established, at the manager's discretion, for all jumping classes. Riders who anticipate a conflict must arrange their order of go with the gate person.

FARRIER AND VETERINARIAN

A farrier will be on-site during the show. Hagyard Equine Institute (859-255-8741) will be on-call during the show. Contact the show office for information.

EMT

An EMT will be on the grounds starting Thursday, September 16 from 8:00 AM to 7:00 p.m. and all day Friday, September 17 through the end of the show on Sunday, September 19.

RINGS

The ring sizes are as follows: Stonelea Ring, 140' x 280', fine sand and GGT fiber on PVC mats; Claiborne Ring, 140' x 270', fine sand and GGT fiber on PVC mats; and Murphy Ring, 135' x 280', fine sand and GGT fiber on PVC mats.

HUNTERS

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, stone wall, in-and-out, oxers, post-and-rail, gate, aiken, and panel. In some classes, the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be set in the ring. All classes to be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise specified. Championships will be given in all divisions.

In all under saddle classes, horses will be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Martingales are not permitted.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE

- Braiding is not required but is encouraged for hunter derby and KHJA Medal Finals classes.
- Horses showing in classes in which they were not previously entered will be required to pay a double entry fee for those classes.
- A processing fee of \$50 plus collection fees will be made for any nonnegotiable checks.
- Non showing horses will be assessed a fee of \$75 in addition to stabling charges and an administration fee.
- All horses without a stall will pay a \$40 grounds fee.
- All horses will be charged \$10 Horse Park ring maintenance fee.
- No scratch fee. Enter all classes you might show in.
- A 3% convenience fee will be charged to us a credit card
- This event is sanctioned by KHJA and will follow USEF rules when applicable.

DIVISIONS AND CLASSES

AMATEUR-OWNER HUNTER 3'3"

Open to horses ridden by an amateur owner or an amateur member of the owner's family, who is no longer eligible to compete as a Junior. An Amateur-Owner may compete one (1) different horse in the Adult Amateur division. To be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on manners. Fence height: 3'3". Section fee: \$90. Individual class fee: \$25.

Class 1, 2, 3: AMATEUR OWNER HUNTER 3'3"

Class 4: AMATEUR OWNER HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

JUNIOR HUNTER 3'3"

Open to horses over 14.2 hands and to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Entries must be handled by Juniors in all phases. Horses shown in this section may cross-enter into another section if eligible. A Junior may compete one (1) different horse in the Children's Hunter division. To be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on manners. Fence height: 3'3". Section fee: \$90. Individual class fee: \$25.

Class 5, 6, 7: JUNIOR HUNTER 3'3"

LOW WORKING HUNTER

Open to all horses. Fence height: 3'. Section fee: \$90. Individual classes: \$25.

GREEN WORKING HUNTER

Open to horses of any age in its first or second year of showing over 3' fences. See USEF rule HU 130 for complete definition. Fence height: 3'-3'3". Section fee: \$90. Individual class fee: \$25.

Class 16: GREEN HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Open to Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Juniors. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same show where fences exceed 3'3". Horses may not cross-enter into Amateur Owner Hunter at the same show. Fence height: 3'. Section fee: \$90. Individual class fee: \$25.

Class 17, 18, 19: ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Class 20: ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by a Junior. Neither horse nor rider may cross-enter into the Junior Hunter or Pony Hunter sections at the same show. Spreads not to exceed fence heights. Fence height: 3'. Section fee: \$90. Individual class fee: \$25.

Class 21, 22, 23: CHILDREN'S HUNTER

THOROUGHBRED HUNTER

Open to registered Thoroughbreds. Fence height: 2'6" and 3'. Section fee: \$70. Individual class fee: \$25.

BABY GREEN HUNTER

Open to all horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing that have not shown over fences higher than 2'9". Cannot cross-enter into classes where fences exceed 2'9". Fence height: 2'6". Section fee: \$90. Individual class fee: \$25.

Class 35, 36, 37: BABY GREEN HUNTER

Class 38: BABY GREEN HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

PRE/INTERMEDIATE ADULT HUNTER

Open to horses ridden by riders 18 years of age or older. Riders may not cross-enter into any classes where fences are 3' or higher at the same show. Fence height: 2'3"-2'6". Section fee: \$90. Individual class fee: \$25.

Class 39, 40, 41: PRE/INTERMEDIATE ADULT HUNTER

Class 42: PRE/INTERMEDIATE ADULT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Courses in the jumper divisions may consist of any combination of the following: brush, gates, oxers, post and rails, liverpools, walls, panels, and coop. Horses that are tied for other than first place will be placed according to their first-round time. A rotating jump order will be established as required. Jumper championships will be decided by points won throughout the section.
